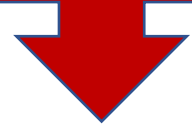

To help children in mainstream schools with targeted strategies & support to receive the education they require to overcome their difficulties

Tier 3 support:

- Help develop effective behaviour management strategies.
- Review and development of behaviour support plans.
- Inclusion strategies
- Advice on differentiation and curriculum development.
- Facilitate inclusion with parents and external professionals for additional support.
- Review existing strategies and implement new ones.

Stage 1 – School support

School SENCO and teaching staff visit Larwood for a guided teaching tour.

Stage 2 – School & Class support

SENCO and/or class teaching staff visit a Larwood class for 2 x half day visits.
1 x am visit 09:00-11:30
1 x pm visit 13:00-15:00.

Stage 3 – School, Class and pupil support

SENCO and/or class teaching staff visit a Larwood class for:
1 x Initial guided teaching tour
2 x Full day visits.
09:30-14:30

Family support - formalised input into every case load.

Targeted parent training sessions (where needed)
Autism, ADHD, De Escalation etc

Targeted transition support for SENCO teams

SENCO review offer looking at external agency referral and pathways.

Mental health SENCO training, support.

EHCP support where SEMH presenting need and likely to attend Larwood.

Be part of the DSPL2 monitoring caseloads, crisis intervention.

I will be inviting schools to visit us at Larwood in the near future to receive a presentation of these developments,, in more detail than you are all receiving in this email. Would there be interest in including a Tier 2 presentation of the services available through this service on the same evening?

We can clearly make this as big or as small as we want to and I'm happy to organise the event here at Larwood with refreshments etc. Ideally I'd be looking to involve the in/out reach staff to share some of the resources/strategies we use daily at Larwood as a way of promoting the services we can provide.

Phase 1 - Tier 3 Outreach programme

Schools apply for Tier 3 in the same way as they do at present with the same criteria required at present, Tier 1 then 2, 3 and so on.

Phase 2 – Targeted IN-REACH programme

I propose that Tier 2 and Tier 3 staff visiting schools can offer this level of service. I will create a simple application form so that we can keep track of those visiting, to help timetable school visits and provide data regarding what schools, year groups and number of staff (teaching and support staff) accessing the service.

Phase 3 – Specialist Intervention Programme

Initially this will be based on Tier 3 staff referrals based on the support highlighted in discussions with school staff during Tier 3 observation visits.
